

	NOTE: Adam and Eve had been created by God and they now needed to choose to obey their Creator. God's command was clear and simple and Adam and Eve understood it (Genesis 3:1-3). It was a small test and easy to obey. God did not explain the reason why he forbade them from eating of this particular tree though He did explain what the consequences would be if they did. God simply wanted Adam and Eve to demonstrate their trust in His word by obeying it!

	"The Woman said, "The serpent me, and I ate." "			
	(Genesis 3:13)			
	NOTE: The apostle Paul explains .that the serpent deceived Eve by his craftiness. (2 Corinthians 1 1:3). Several things come to mind when we think of the word "deception." 1) In order for deception to be successful it must make the counterfeit appear as closely possible to the genuine. 2) The counterfeit always comes after the genuine in time. 3) The only way to detect the counterfeit is to compare it with the genuine. That is to say, only by knowing the truth, can we detect error!
