Psalms 86:5 Palms together; then open as if opening a book.

Grow Crouch down and gradually stand up.

in the grace Clasp arms over chest.

of . . . Jesus. Point upward.

2 Peter 3:18 Palms together; then open as if opening a book.

Thanks Clap your hands five times.

be to God Point upward.
