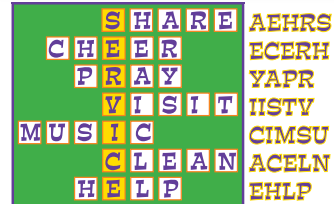
## Puzzle 6 Answer

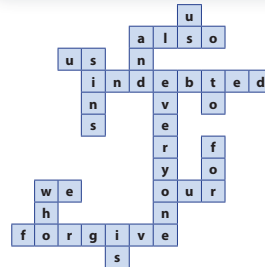
## Puzzle 7 Answer

"But grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ. To Him be the glory both now and forever! Amen" (2 Peter 3:18).

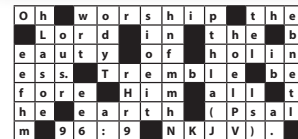
